The aims of this workshop are to:

- train health care personnel; causes and prevention of cardiopulmonary arrest, the ABCDE approach, initial resuscitation and defibrillation (manual and/or AED) and simple airway management
- train healthcare personnel to manage patients in cardiopulmonary arrest until arrival of the resuscitation team
- train healthcare personnel to participate as members of the resuscitation team
